University Fellowship Programme
Supported by Sir Run Run Shaw Endowment Fund

1. Objectives

The Programme is to strengthen and enhance research and teaching, and to foster research collaboration among local and overseas scholars. Appointment of Fellows are expected to engage in research and other scholarly activities, jointly with colleagues of the University if possible, and to conduct public lectures in their areas of specialisation.

2. The Scheme

2.1 The fund together with the accrued income will be used to support the appointment of maximum **eight** distinguished University Fellow each year to deliver courses, public lectures, seminars, workshops, etc. on their niche areas of specialisation. Eminent scholars from outside Hong Kong with outstanding academic or research achievements their respective disciplines may apply. The appointment period will range from two months to one semester.

2.2 The scheme is supported by the Sir Run Run Shaw Endowment Fund. The benefit* to University Fellows is set out below:

Salary/ Honorarium (HK\$)	Max. \$40,000 per month
Accommodation Subsidies (HK\$)	University housing (7.5% of stipend)
Travel Allowance	Reimbursement for round-trip economy class airfare (of the shortest route) of up to \$15,000
Insurance	Short-term medical insurance

** Faculties/Schools/AVA may offer additional benefits at its own funding*
